

The 2025 Missions Conference Flag Ceremony will be held on Sunday, March 9, 2025. Participants will line up in costume (or church clothes) in the children's wing and move up to collect flags in the Ambassador Room, then to the foyer to march in for a roll call of nations early in the morning service. They will then return to gather as a mass "choir" at the front of the auditorium to join in the Mission Conference theme song for this year.

Registration is open today for adults, teens, children, families to participate in this year's ceremony. Deadline to register to participate is Sunday, February 9th!

We would also welcome adult volunteers to assist with practices, during the flag ceremony and to sit with children on the balcony for the remainder of the service. At the end of the service, children will be dismissed as parents arrive for pick up at the bottom of the balcony stairs.

The church answering machine will have a mesage stating that the services have been cancelled. When you call the church office press '6' to listen to the message.

When there is a weather advisory, there is a good chance we will cancel a service. If you are in doubt, before you leave home, please call the church office and press "6" to listen to the message on the answering machine. We encourage you to use your own judgment whether to travel as the weather may be more severe where you live.

AM Sermon Notes

Message: Message: What is Faith?

Hebrews 11:1-3 Pastor Tim Knaus

I. What is Faith?

- A. This morning, we come to one of the most beloved chapters in the Book of Hebrews, chapter 11.
- B. The basic Biblical word for faith means belief, trust, or confidence, but verse one expresses this definition in two parallel and almost identical phrases.

John 20:29

2 Corinthians 5:7

- II. A Life Pleasing to God
 - A. From Genesis to Revelation, people please God when they walk by faith.
 - B. One of the greatest acts of faith for a Christian is to believe that God spoke the universe into existence.
 - C. Throughout this study of Hebrews chapter 11, I want each of us to think carefully about what it means to be a man or woman who walks by faith.

Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (I am a sinner)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (Be saved by faith)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (Receive him as Lord and Savior)

We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
