

AM Sermon Notes

Message: By Faith Noah Obeyed God in Reverent Fear Hebrews 11:7 Pastor Tim Knaus

Faith and Obedience

A. If you really believe in God, there will be evidence of it in the way you live, in the things you say, and in the things you do.

James 2:26

Ephesians 2:8-10

B. Noah was a man of great faith, a faith demonstrated by his absolute trust in God and his relentless obedience.

Genesis 6:9

- II. The Attitude of Noah
 - A. In verse seven, we learn that Noah obeyed God in "reverent fear."
 - B. Besides saving his household, two other powerful things happened due to Noah's faith-filled obedience.
 - C. I want to close this morning with three additional observations about this man of faith.

Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (I am a sinner)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (Be saved by faith)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (Receive him as Lord and Savior)

We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
