Missions Conference Book Table

During the conference we will have a table with books and audio books available from the Library that you can check out. Examples are: Francis Asbury(1745-1816) - Francis was born in England in 1745. He travelled to America and became a circuit Methodist preacher in New England.Rowland Bingham (1872-1942) Rowland was born in England in 1872. He started Sudan interior mission (SIM) to Sudan and Ethiopia. Amy Carmichael(1867-1951) Amy was born in Ireland in 1867. Amy reached out to people in the slums of Belfast. Mary Slessor (1848—1915) Mary's Slessor was born in 1848 in Scotland. She went on to become a missionary to Nigeria and West Africa. Some of these may be available as Audio Books

Missionary Prayer Albums Missions Update and Prayer Guides

Ephesians 2:11-22 (NIV)

Peace with God

Peace with Man

United with Him for a Purpose

Reflection:

Where do I operate in life with godly peace or worldy/false peace? (with God & with others)

Where do I need to experience the gospel? How will this help me engage in his purpose for my life? (honoring and glorifying Him, v. 21: being built as a part of holy temple in the Lord, being a part of His plan to build the church from all nations)

Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (I am a sinner)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (Be saved by faith)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (Receive him as Lord and Savior)

We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
