

#### Message: Why Did Christ Come into the World? Part 2 Matthew 1:23 Pastor Tim Knaus

- I. A Loneliness that Haunts the Soul
  - A. Above all else that we could say about Christmas: Jesus came into our world to save us from our sins.

1 Timothy 1:15

B. At the heart of the human condition lies a deep and unshakable loneliness.

Ephesians 2:12

- II. They Shall Call His Name Immanuel
  - A. This is the beauty of Christmas: God came into the world not only to save us, but also to live in constant, abiding fellowship with us.
  - B. Of all the Biblical promises given to a Christian, one of the most comforting and glorious is the truth that you are never alone.

Romans 8:38-39

John 14:16–17

## Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (*I am a sinner*)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (*Be saved by faith*)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (*Receive him as Lord and Savior*)

## We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
