

AM Sermon Notes

Message: Why Did Christ Come into the World? Part 3 Luke 2:10-14 Pastor Tim Knaus

- I. Glory to God
 - A. The first two parts of this series will lead us Biblically and logically to part three.
 - B. The birth of a Savior, Christ the Lord, is to show the world that God is infinitely great, beautiful, valuable, and worthy of all the praise and glory we could give Him.
- II. Joy to Us
 - A. The birth of a Savior in the city of David is the coming of the joy of the Lord for all who will believe in Him and embrace Him as Savior.

Matthew 2:10-11

B. It can be a life-changing truth when we realize that giving glory to God always results in the joy of His people.

Revelation 5:11-12

Luke 24:52

Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (I am a sinner)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (*Be saved by faith*)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (*Receive him as Lord and Savior*)

We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
