



- I. Change is Inevitable A. Next year, 2025, will be a year of change.
  - B. Beware of building your life on sinking sand.
- II. The Solid Rock
  - A. If you build your life on the Rock, you will be able to withstand all of the storms of this life.
  - B. A new year is the perfect opportunity for you to grow stronger in Christ than ever before.

#### Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (I am a sinner)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (*Be saved by faith*)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (*Receive him as Lord and Savior*)

#### We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
