Cancellation of Church/Activities

Wednesday nights: When St. Johns Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, all church activities will be cancelled for that evening. If inclement weather develops late in the afternoon, the pastors may feel we need to cancel all activities. If the service has been cancelled, the church answering machine will have a message stating that the services have been cancelled. Call the church office and press '6' to listen to the message.

Weekdays: When St. Johns Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, all church activities will be cancelled for that day. All meetings scheduled for that day will be cancelled unless the meeting can be conducted virtually. Beacon of Hope: All Beacon of Hope programs and food distribution times will be cancelled for the entirety of that day.

Sunday Services: If inclement weather develops and the pastors feel we need to cancel one or all services, the church answering machine will have a message stating that the services have been cancelled. Call the church office and press '6' to listen to the message.

If there is a weather advisory, there is a good chance we will cancel a service. If you are in doubt, before you leave home, please call the church office and press "6" to listen to the message on the answering machine. We encourage you to use your own judgment whether to travel as the weather may be more severe where you live.

Our Text Alert System will send you a text message on your phone as soon as a decision to cancel a service is made.
