

# 2015 – 2016 Parent handbook



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### Welcome to Awana:

The purpose of the Awana ministry is to reach boys and girls with the gospel of Christ and train them to serve Him. The Awana ministry at First Baptist Church works in unison with the other ministries at FBC to help your child learn about Jesus and to grow in Him.

This handbook is intended to provide you with some important information regarding our current Awana club year. Awana begins September 16, 2015 and runs through April 27, 2016 and will be held on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 to 8:00 pm. Please see the Awana calendar for specific dates and descriptions of theme nights.

#### Programs:

Cubbies: The two years prior to Kindergarten (3 & 4 year olds)

Sparks: Kindergarten thru Second Grade

Truth & Training (T&T): Third Grade thru Sixth Grade

**Nursery:** Parents attending any ministry of FBC on Wednesday nights (Awana, Bible study, prayer meeting, etc.) may bring their infant thru two year olds to nursery.

## Registration:

# <u>Cost:</u>

Each year we ask for dues to be paid to help purchase awards, teaching materials, special events, and store supplies for the children. These dues cover the entire club year and amount to less than 65¢ per week. Clubbers will also need to purchase a book and uniform by the time they complete their entrance booklets. If paying by check, please make the check payable to **First Baptist Church.** 

Please let the Commander or Secretary know if paying is a financial hardship for you. (Installment payments are also accepted.) We want everyone to be able to participate in this important ministry.

\*\* Clubbers in attendance the 1<sup>st</sup> week of October will be given one canvas tote bag to decorate that they could use as a book bag.

If you have a uniform that your child is no longer using, please consider bringing it in and we will pass it on to benefit a child that doesn't have one.

### Drop Off Process:

For your child's protection, you must come to the Children's Wing (located in the Lower Level) to check-in your child(ren). During check-in you will be given a "Pick-Up" card that must be presented at check-out. **No child may be dropped off at Awana without being checked in by an authorized person.** 

PLEASE DO NOT DROP OFF CLUBBERS BEFORE 6:15 PM as our leaders need time to prepare for the evening and are unavailable to supervise children before this time.

Children SHOULD NOT attend Awana if they have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (100 deg. or higher), vomiting, or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- Runny nose if accompanied by other symptoms and/or colored discharge
- Bad Cough Coughing increases the chance of infection being spread to others
- Any rash that is suspected to be contagious
- If your child is prescribed an antibiotic, they must have been on the antibiotic for a minimum of 48 hours prior to attending Awana.

### Pick Up Process:

Check-out is at 8:00 PM in the area in front of the Children's Wing. (Please be prompt). Upon presentation of the pick-up card received at check-in, children will be released from their classroom to their authorized person.

#### Authorized persons must be in 9<sup>th</sup> grade or older.

Please know that we require these safeguards only to insure your child's safety. Thank you!

# Cancellations / Inclement Weather:

If St. Johns Public Schools are cancelled or dismissed early due to bad weather, Awana will be cancelled.

If the forecast is calling for a severe snow/ice storm during Awana, we will error on the side of caution and cancel Awana.

#### Dress Code:

Uniforms are required for all registered clubbers and should be worn each week. Clubbers will earn store credits when they wear their uniform. If a Sparks' clubber does not have their uniform on, awards will be held until the next time their uniform is worn.

Children attending Awana should wear comfortable clothing and athletic shoes to participate in the activities held on a typical evening. Some activities may be difficult to participate in wearing skirts, heels, flip-flops, sandals, dress shoes, etc.

# What to Bring:

- Awana Uniform
- Bible
- Awana Club Handbook or Entrance Booklet
- Comfortable Shoes

Your child should not bring electronic devices with them. If your child brings something which does not pertain to Awana, they will be asked to put it away and keep it out of sight.

### <u>Rules:</u>

- Follow leader instructions and speak to your leaders with respect
- Stay in your room unless a leader gives you permission to leave
- Move quietly between rooms. Walk, do not run, in the church
- Respect each other and do not touch others' things
- Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself at all times

#### Handbook Verses:

- Verses should be memorized word for word with one help per verse, according to the Awana guidelines.
- Leaders will be sensitive to each child's ability. Children that have an easy time memorizing verses will be encouraged to learn them without any help. Those that struggle memorizing, may be allowed more than one help without penalty.
- It is important to complete Handbook sections, in order, for all T&T handbooks and for Sparks' Red Jewel sections. If a section is skipped because the clubber is still working on that section, they should return to complete it as soon as possible. Clubbers should not jump around to complete the "easier" sections first. Handbooks are created in a specific order to facilitate learning the materials.
- Clubbers that finish their handbooks will be encouraged to complete extra credit items.

# Your Involvement is Needed:

Moms, Dads, Grandparents, and anyone else special in a clubber's life. You are essential in helping your clubber get the most enjoyment and fulfillment out of the Awana program.

- Encourage your clubber to attend Awana every week. This consistency will help your child to excel. Be sure that your clubber arrives on time. Promptness helps our ministry stay on track.
- Clubbers are required to wear their uniform, bring their Bible and handbook. Clubbers will be awarded Awana store credits for each of these things. If they do not have a uniform, casual clothes and tennis shoes should be worn.
- Help your child prepare for club each week by spending time at home with them reading and reviewing their Handbook material. If they do not have a Bible, please contact the club director. Bibles are needed to complete the Handbook. If your child does not have one, we will provide one. We use the ESV (English Standard Version) Bible.
- Encourage your child by familiarizing yourself with their Handbook, especially the activities. Often those sections require more time and involve home related tasks and activities.
- Remind them to spend 5 10 minutes each day on verses. Memorizing is hard work but your involvement will validate the child's efforts and motivate them to complete the handbook within the club year. Awana clubbers may be limited to how many sections their leader can sign for on a given night, depending on the group they participate in.
- Always encourage your Awana Clubber. Children have much more fun when someone shows an interest in their accomplishments.

## Awana Store & Credits:

Sparks and T&T clubbers earn credits to spend in our Awana Store as follows:

Clubbers may save their weekly credits toward earning the "bigger" items offered in the Store or they may spend them as they earn them.

#### Awards Ceremony:

On the last Wednesday in April, we will have an Awana Awards Ceremony to honor the accomplishments of all our clubbers. Family and friends are invited and encouraged to attend.

After checking-in clubbers, parents and visitor may proceed to the Auditorium. Clubbers will be brought up and will sit in a group with their club. **ALL clubbers WILL receive an award.**
