By Faith Noah Obeyed God in Reverent Fear – Hebrews 11:7

Hebrews 11:7

⁷By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.

I. Faith and Obedience

- A. If you really believe in God, there will be evidence of it in the way you live, in the things you say, and in the things you do.

James 2:26

²⁶For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead.

Ephesians 2:8–10

⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

¹⁰For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

- B. Noah was a man of great faith, a faith demonstrated by his absolute trust in God and his relentless obedience.

Genesis 6:9

⁹These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.

II. The Attitude of Noah

- A. In verse seven, we learn that Noah obeyed God in “reverent fear.”
- B. Besides saving his household, two other powerful things happened due to Noah’s faith-filled obedience.
- C. I want to close this morning with three additional observations about this man of faith.
