

Message: The Profit of Contentment

1 Tim 6:3-10

Contentment Defined:

Christian contentment means that our satisfaction is independent of circumstances.

1. The Life of Discontentment

- a. Unsatisfied Teachers
- b. Unsatisfied Activities

2. The Pathway of Discontentment

- a. The Path is Deceptive
- b. The Path is Dangerous
- c. The Path is Destructive

3. The Profit of Contentment

4. The Cure For Our Discontentment

Here is how you can accept Christ into your life:

- Admit your need. (I am a sinner)
- Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave. (Be saved by faith)
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to control your life through the Holy Spirit. (Receive him as Lord and Savior)

We suggest a prayer like this one:

"Dear God, I know I'm a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died for my sin and that you raised Him to life. I want to trust Him as my Savior and follow Him as Lord, from this day forward. Guide my life and help me to do your will. I pray this in the name of Jesus. Amen."
